

The Bridge to Nowhere Directions


Directions to Azusa: The city of Azusa is located off the 210 freeway approx. 2 miles east of the 210/605 freeway intersection.

From 210/605 intersection, follow 210 freeway east 2 miles.

Exit the 210 freeway at Azusa Ave. (Also named: Highway 39).

When you exit the 210 fwy, set your odometer to “Zero”. Your driving directions from this point will be measured using the 210 fwy exit as your starting point.

Follow Azusa Ave. Northbound through downtown Azusa heading towards the mountains.



Mile mark 3: You will pass the Angeles National Forest Information Center. Continue on San Gabriel Canyon Road as it heads into the mountains.

There is NO cellular service beyond this point!



Approx. mile mark 11.5: Turn right onto East Fork Road and go over a long brown steel bridge. Continue on East Fork Road.



Approx. mile mark 16.6: You will come to a “3-Way Intersection” with East Fork Road, and Camp Bonita Road. Turn left onto Camp Bonita Road (Do not turn right onto Glendora Mountain Road).



Go approx, 1/4 mile on Camp Bonita Road and cross over a white wooden bridge. Continue 1/2 mile past the wooden bridge until the road dead ends in a paved parking lot. You will see your instructors here. Now it is time to get ready for the adventure of a lifetime!
